# PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2024/2025

This season was a special one for the club with no less than 6 junior and senior premierships. With the lights on the Blackman Park nets enabling players to train at night, all members were able to benefit fully from the infrastructure upgrade.

I would like to thank the committee for their contribution to prepare for the season well in advance by recruiting 3 overseas imports who would come to make significant contributions to the club, playing and coaching.

For the 1<sup>st</sup> time in 17 seasons, the club managed to qualify for the Under 24s semi-finals and proceeded to claim the Frank Gray Trophy at Weldon on a Sunday afternoon in February 2025, defending 260 off their 50 overs.

Our First-Grade limited overs team also won the Limited Overs premiership, our 1<sup>st</sup> in only the 2<sup>nd</sup> season of the competition. Chasing 210, we cruised to victory on the batting of skipper Michael Bryant.

Thank you to our sponsors: Belle Property Lane Cove, Kingston Financial, LBD Landscaping and Kingsgrove Sports.

A special mention must go to Andrew Bray who took over as the Vice President - Seniors and ran the seniors with a no fuss, can do attitude. His phone calls and wisdom greatly assisted the running of the club at various stage during the season.

The Juniors under new Vice President - Juniors Bevan Guest increased junior numbers to 290 players last season and 35 Junior Blasters. Along with the great participation numbers, the Juniors had great results, including winning 4 premierships: 2 Under 10 Boys' and 2 Girls'.

Plans are well underway for 2025/2026 season with the hope that more Seniors will want to play which will reduce the cost of the Senior subscription fees.

As our Treasurer Paul Bakker will note, we have spent approximately \$100,000 on Council fees in the last season, something we will look to reduce over the coming season.

We as a club need to unite or die, as it becomes progressively harder each year to run a cricket club.

Finally, thank you to Lane Cove Council for all the work on grounds last season. With new covers at Tantallon and a new small cover at KSO, we look forward to improved pitches in the upcoming season.

# **TREASURER'S REPORT 2024/2025**

# Membership and Participation

After a few years of stagnation, we were pleased to see a further increase in player subscriptions. Junior subscriptions, while slightly below their historical peak, remain solid. Encouragingly, the Club continues to see growth in junior boys' and girls' cricket, reinforcing our strategic focus on inclusivity and future development.

Team numbers across both Senior and Junior levels remain consistent. Player numbers will remain a critical factor in preserving the Club's financial sustainability.

### **Financial Results**

For the year ended 30 April 2025, the Club reported a net loss of \$31,010, after factoring in operational results and other income including donations and grants.

Key figures include:

• Total revenue: \$178,302 (↑ from \$149,446 in 2024)

Major expense areas:

• Ground hire: \$97,773 (↑ from \$42,540)

• Equipment and balls: \$32,139

• Registration fees (including NSJCA): \$37,296

The Club also recognised a \$26,711 prior-year ground hire adjustment, which has impacted on the reported result.

Despite the reported deficit, the Club continues to maintain a solid cash reserve of \$92,329 and total net assets of \$79,060. These figures reflect prudent historical management and give us confidence in navigating future pressures.

# **Outlook and Risk Management**

Looking ahead, the Club faces a range of significantly increased expenses that must be carefully managed in the years to come. The most material of these are:

- Ground hire, which has already more than doubled over the past few years, and is expected to rise further.
- Player registration and NSJCA fees, which continue to trend upward, and are also expected to increase by 10% for the 2025/26 year.
- The potential future introduction or escalation of umpire costs, particularly as Cricket NSW has indicated it will no longer cover these costs despite a significant increase in the registration fees paid by players to Cricket Australia who contribute funding to Cricket NSW.

These expenses represent structural challenges that could place pressure on the Club's financial model.

The Committee is actively reviewing all cost drivers to ensure that any increases are matched with thoughtful planning. While we remain committed to keeping cricket affordable and accessible, player subscription levels may need to be reassessed for 2025/26 and beyond if these costs cannot be absorbed through other efficiencies or increased external funding.

Despite these challenges, the Committee proposes to maintain Senior Registration fees at \$700 and Junior Registration fees at \$425 (excluding the Cricket Australia fee).

Maintaining healthy registration numbers and securing ongoing support from sponsors and donors will be essential in offsetting these financial headwinds.

### **Investment in the Future**

It has been heartening to welcome new players to the sport and the Club. The importance of investing in our junior teams cannot be overstated — they are the future of the Lane Cove Cricket Club. Programs that support their growth and enjoyment will remain a key focus in the years ahead. A big thank you to those players who assisted in Junior coaching throughout the year.

### Acknowledgements

On behalf of the Committee, I extend our sincere gratitude to all our sponsors, donors, volunteers, and supporters. Your continued commitment is vital to our success.

Thank you also to our captains, coaches, junior reps, parents, and players who help make Lane Cove Cricket Club a respected and thriving part of the Sydney cricket community.

### **Conclusion**

Despite rising costs, Lane Cove Cricket Club is well positioned. With sound governance, a growing player base, and dedicated community support, we remain confident in the Club's direction and its long-term future.

# Lane Cove Cricket Club Incorporated Notes to the financial statements 30 April 2025

### Note 1. Significant accounting policies

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the years presented, unless otherwise stated.

### New, revised or amending Accounting Standards and Interpretations adopted

The incorporated association has adopted all of the new, revised or amending Accounting Standards and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board ('AASB') that are mandatory for the current reporting period.

Any new, revised or amending Accounting Standards or Interpretations that are not yet mandatory have not been early adopted.

### **Basis of preparation**

In the officers' opinion, the incorporated association is not a reporting entity because there are no users dependent on general purpose financial statements.

These are special purpose financial statements that have been prepared for the purposes of complying with the New South Wales legislation the Associations Incorporation Act 2009, the Charitable Fundraising Act 1991 and associated regulations. The officers have determined that the accounting policies adopted are appropriate to meet the needs of the members of the Lane Cove Cricket Club Inc.

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement requirements specified by the Australian Accounting Standards and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board ('AASB') and the disclosure requirements of AASB 101 'Presentation of Financial Statements', AASB 107 'Statement of Cash Flows', AASB 108 'Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors', AASB 1031 'Materiality', AASB 1048 'Interpretation of Standards' and AASB 1054 'Australian Additional Disclosures', as appropriate for not-for-profit oriented entities.

### Revenue recognition

Revenue is recognised when it is probable that the economic benefit will flow to the incorporated association and the revenue can be reliably measured. Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable.

### Sales revenue

Events, fundraising and raffles are recognised when received or receivable.

### **Donations**

Donations are recognised at the time the pledge is made.

### Grants

Grants are recognised at their fair value where there is a reasonable assurance that the grant will be received, and all attached conditions will be complied with.

### Interest

Interest revenue is recognised as interest accrues using the effective interest method. This is a method of calculating the amortised cost of a financial asset and allocating the interest income over the relevant period using the effective interest rate, which is the rate that exactly discounts estimated future cash receipts through the expected life of the financial asset to the net carrying amount of the financial asset.

### Other revenue

Other revenue is recognised when it is received or when the right to receive payment is established.

### Income tax

As the incorporated association is a charitable institution in terms of subsection 50-5 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997, as amended, it is exempt from paying income tax.

# Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

### **Current and non-current classification**

Assets and liabilities are presented in the statement of financial position based on current and non-current classification.

An asset is current when: it is expected to be realised or intended to be sold or consumed in normal operating cycle; it is held primarily for the purpose of trading; it is expected to be realised within twelve months after the reporting period; or the asset is cash or cash equivalent unless restricted from being exchanged or used to settle a liability for at least twelve months after the reporting period. All other assets are classified as non-current.

A liability is current when: it is expected to be settled in normal operating cycle; it is held primarily for the purpose of trading; it is due to be settled within twelve months after the reporting period; or there is no unconditional right to defer the settlement of the liability for at least twelve months after the reporting period. All other liabilities are classified as non-current.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities are always classified as non-current.

### Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents includes cash on hand, deposits held at call with financial institutions, other short-term, highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash, and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value.

### Trade and other receivables

Other receivables are recognised at amortised cost, less any provision for impairment.

### Property, plant and equipment

Plant and equipment is stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the items.

Depreciation is calculated on a straight-line basis to write off the net cost of each item of property, plant and equipment (excluding land) over their expected useful lives as follows:

Buildings40 yearsFreehold improvements15 yearsPlant and equipment3-7 yearsMotor vehicles5-7 yearsOffice equipment3-5 years

The residual values, useful lives and depreciation methods are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at each reporting date.

An item of property, plant and equipment is derecognised upon disposal or when there is no future economic benefit to the incorporated association. Gains and losses between the carrying amount and the disposal proceeds are taken to profit or loss.

### Impairment of non-financial assets

Non-financial assets are reviewed for impairment whenever events or changes in circumstances indicate that the carrying amount may not be recoverable. An impairment loss is recognised for the amount by which the asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount.

Recoverable amount is the higher of an asset's fair value less costs of disposal and value-in-use. The value-in-use is the present value of the estimated future cash flows relating to the asset using a pre-tax discount rate specific to the asset or cash-generating unit to which the asset belongs. Assets that do not have independent cash flows are grouped together to form a cash-generating unit.

# Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

### Trade and other payables

These amounts represent liabilities for goods and services provided to the incorporated association prior to the end of the financial year and which are unpaid. Due to their short-term nature they are measured at amortised cost and are not discounted. The amounts are unsecured and are usually paid within 30 days of recognition.

### Fair value measurement

When an asset or liability, financial or non-financial, is measured at fair value for recognition or disclosure purposes, the fair value is based on the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date; and assumes that the transaction will take place either: in the principle market; or in the absence of a principal market, in the most advantageous market.

Fair value is measured using the assumptions that market participants would use when pricing the asset or liability, assuming they act in their economic best interest. For non-financial assets, the fair value measurement is based on its highest and best use. Valuation techniques that are appropriate in the circumstances and for which sufficient data are available to measure fair value, are used, maximising the use of relevant observable inputs and minimising the use of unobservable inputs.

# Report on the financial report

I have audited the accompanying financial report, being a special purpose financial report, of the Lane Cove Cricket Club Inc., which comprises the statement of financial position as at 30 April 2025, the statement of profit or loss for the year then ended, notes comprising a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information, and the officers' assertion statement.

Officers' responsibility for the financial report

The officers of the Lane Cove Cricket Inc. are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial report and have determined that the basis of preparation described in Note 1, is appropriate to meet the requirements of the Act and is appropriate to meet the needs of the members. The officers' responsibility also includes such internal control as the officers determine is necessary to enable the preparation and fair presentation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

### Auditor's responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the financial report based on our audit. We have conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Those standards require that we comply with relevant ethical requirements relating to audit engagements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial report is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial report. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial report, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the association's preparation and fair presentation of the financial report in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the association's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the officers, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial report.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

### Opinion

In my opinion, the financial report gives a true and fair view of the financial position of the Lane Cove Cricket Club Inc. as at 30 April 2025, and its financial performance for the year then ended.

Basis of accounting

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to Note 1 to the financial report, which describes the basis of accounting. # SEASON 2024/25 SENIOR CLUB REPORTS

# First Grade Report – 2024/25

1s went into the season full of excitement and hope. With some spin and batting depth picked up, it felt like it could be an ideal balance of cricketers and personalities to make a run for some premierships. Many recent seasons of so close yet so far had the boys desperate to break our premiership drought and returning skippers Corny and Rig thought we just might have the squad to do it.

Unfortunately, our availability early in the season wasn't great and together with some poor performances meant we lost Round 1 when we should have won, scraped through Round 2 with a win before being chased down in Round 3. Finally, Round 4 showed us putting up the type of performance we knew we were capable of, dismantling Southern Districts who would go on to become minor premiers. A convincing 5 wicket win against Souths in Round 5 had us believing we were onto something, before a washout against Norwest in Round 6 when we were significantly ahead of the game halted momentum.

Round 7 brought with it our worst performance of the season, where nothing much went right, and we were convincingly beaten by Epping. Perhaps it was the loss we needed though as we went on to roll Burwood in Round 8 with a significantly depleted side. A washout without a ball bowled in Round 9 took us to Round 10 and the last of the one-day games. Sitting outside the one-day top 4 and having all but lost belief of a maiden one-day finals series, we went on to play one of our games of the year. Scoring 163, we then rolled Warringah for 54, picking up a bonus point in the process and sneaking our way into finals. Whilst we waited for the one-day finals to roll around with our bye in Round 11, we then outrighted Penno in Round 12 to take lots of momentum into the business end of the season.

The boys were playing some really good cricket and went into the one-day final series with a lot of optimism, knowing that our best cricket was going to be very hard to beat. The semi-final came around and we were going up against first place Strathfield. A rare toss win saw us setting a total, with lots of our top and middle order chipping in, we put up an impressive 273 off our 50 overs. Our bowlers all had a role to play but our spin led from the front to bowl Strathfield out for 187 and we were into our first 1s grand final in 13 years.

The grand final saw us heading out to Southern Districts for the big day. Losing the toss (shock) meant we were bowling first on a good batting wicket. SDs got off to a good start and we were staring down the barrel of a big chase. Two great run outs changed the game for us with our spin attack then going to work, restricting SDs to 211 all out. We chipped away at the chase early and by the time we were 3 down, we were just shy of halfway. Our 4th wicket partnership then put on an absolute clinic on how to go about run chases. Unfortunately, we lost our 4th wicket just two runs shy of the total but that didn't dampen our spirits as we cruised to a 6 wicket win. An amazing performance by our boys to beat 1st and then 2nd on the ladder in convincing fashion as we finally had some silverware to celebrate.

As the dust settled on our one-day heroics, attention turned to the two-day competition and an attempt at making history being the first club to win both 1st Grade premierships. The final round of the regular season ended with a big win against fellow top 6 club Strathfield, and we were heading into the final series in 3rd place. The home quarter final had us hosting Auburn and after losing the toss (shock), we were batting first. 122 overs later and 296 on the board, we had the knowledge that a draw or a win would see us into the semis. Early wickets put the result all but to bed and as the remaining overs ran down, the captains shook hands.

Into the semi-finals we marched, coming up against Burwood away which hadn't been a happy hunting ground in finals for us. Losing the toss for the umpteenth time this season, we had ball in hand knowing that if we could just manage to get 10 wickets with a decent amount of time left, our batsmen had runs in them to get us into a grand final. Day 1 was a long, tough day as we toiled away. Momentum was hard to come by, but we took semi regular wickets to keep us in it. Finally, the 10th wicket fell with a few overs left in the day which we safely navigated. Turning up to day 2 we had all day to score 260 runs, thinking that if we could just get through the new ball we could chip away at the total with our batting depth. Unfortunately, we had a horror start losing 3 wickets within 3 overs and we never really recovered from there, being bowled out for 103.

A heartbreaking way to go out with our batting being so strong for so many months but credit must go to Burwood for their class once again in finals. Still, it was a season to be so proud of and one that broke our premiership drought. It is great to know that we have what it takes to win comps and hopefully this is just the start of much more success for our first-grade squad and club as a whole. I feel like we had a great mix of personalities this season and it was so much fun being a part of a squad where so many people could turn up on the day and win us the game. It was also great to see so many young guys come into the 1s set up and fill holes when we had players out. I honestly think that we are just scratching the surface of what this great club could do both on and off the field and that is something exciting to be a part of.

# Second Grade Report – 2024/25

We started off the season with a new captain being appointed as well as a fair few new faces in the team. Game 1 was a one dayer against Roseville which turned out to be a low scoring affair. Having bundled out Roseville for 117 runs in 47 overs, we chased the target 7 down with 21 overs to spare bringing in the first win of the season with a bonus point secured. We didn't realise it at the time the importance of this bonus point win in the context of our season.

Shortage of players early in the season forced to make 6 changes for Game 2 away at Linfield. Nonetheless we put up a good fight with the ball with all the new players standing up, however we couldn't quite put together a solid batting effort and fell short of the runs. We followed this up with our first 2 dayer at home vs Auburn. After a strong start to have Auburn 5-63, we let them off the hook and they reached 197. Once again, our batting effort was well below par with a total of 106 which was a disappointing end to the game and a result which should have gone our way against a weaker team.

We went into Game 4 requiring a big turnaround and fight back to get our season back on track, however this wouldn't come easy against top of the table Southern Districts away from home. This is where the season really started for us in my opinion. The fight that we showed to win this game is the same fight that we took into the rest of the season and something I will be looking forward to revamping in the season ahead. After being 7 for 68, Andrew Roberston and Isaac Edmunds steered the team to 192 all out, both scoring 50s and setting up a great finish to Day 1. The pressure we put on in the last session of the day yielded results and we had them on the ropes at 4 for 34. Day 2 required another big effort to reel in the 6 points and a strong bowling effort all round saw us take the win by 31 runs.

We took this confidence into the next game against Balmain away. Putting up a total of 255, our highest of the season, with Ryan Devine batting brilliantly for his 85 runs. A brilliant show of fast pace bowling from Angus Mackay saw him steam through the top order picking up 4 wickets and Ben Greaves clean up the tail with 3 wickets resulting in a 71 run victory and sealing 2 wins in a row away from home vs strong opposition. Unfortunately, we couldn't back this up the following game vs North West, dropping 6 points having scored 79 runs from 31 overs in our first innings of a two dayer game, and we were comfortably beaten at home.

We needed to bounce back strong, and this came against Epping in a thriller one wicket win. We dismissed Epping for 166 thanks to an excellent opening spell by Ned Arnold who took 6 wickets in the innings and his first 5 wicket haul for LCCC. In return we were 8 for 134 and staring down the barrel of another loss. However, the fight shown in earlier games is what got us through and a brilliant partnership from Ned Arnold and Michael O'Donoghue saw us pick up the points and sing the team song loud and proud.

Game 8 saw us take on the old foe Burwood away in a one dayer. This turned out to be by far our worst bowling and fielding performance with Burwood finishing on 6 for 241. To this point, no team had put 200 runs on us. We started strong; however, we lost wickets at crucial points in the game and were all out for 165 with Steve Matheson putting in a shift to bring up his half century. We played Georges River at home next, and they batted well on a wet and tricky wicket to get themselves to 2 for 84 after which the bowlers put in a shift and we closed out the innings at 158, which should have been a very achievable target. This time it

was our batting again which let us down being 7 for 43 at one point to finish 90 all out, with a strong performance of 43 runs at the top of the order by Julian Scott.

The equation was simple at this point if we had any intentions of playing finals cricket; we needed 2 wins from our next 2 games at a minimum, plus a few results to go our way. The lads trained hard and the youngish squad of mostly under 24s were up for the fight and revving to go. First up was Pennant Hills away. We batted first and once again put up a poor performance being all out for 118 on a relatively flat deck. Pennant Hills were 2 for 58 at the last drinks break of the day, and in anyone's books you would have had your money on it being season over for LCCC. However, with the chips down and our season on the line the lads turned the last session into one that all 11 players on the field will never forget. Joe Camarsh kicked off the collapse with two quick wickets in one over and was supported by Angus Mackay at the other end who picked up 5 for 25. In the space of 14 overs, we turned the game on its head picking up the remaining 8 wickets and securing 6 points having skittled the opposition for 88. We were hungry for more and scored an additional 120 runs in the 2<sup>nd</sup> innings setting up a declaration and 150 runs for the opposition to chase in 2 sessions. We got very close to the elusive outright shaking hands at the end of day 2 with Pennant Hills on 7-118.

Our last game of the season was against Strathfield at home. A brilliant all round performance saw us close out the first innings with Strathfield all out 103. In return we had a strong start with Joe Camarsh smashing a quick 47 runs to put us in a commanding position with a lead of 42 runs. Having heard the other match results and scenarios around the grounds, the equation was clear. We needed an outright to play finals cricket otherwise it was season over. This brought renewed energy, focus and determination from the team which is the same fight we showed throughout the season. We worked incredibly hard to get the opposition all out for 121 leaving us with 79 runs to score in the last 8 overs of the day to play finals cricket. Step up Harvey King scoring 41 not out in 28 deliveries to bring home the outright victory, the first of the season and the most important win of the season.

This set up a finals berth against Burwood who were 2<sup>nd</sup> on the table, meeting them at a neutral venue and coming off the back of two solid wins, we always thought we stood a great chance of a win. With significant downpour during the week, it was an important toss to win which we unfortunately didn't. This led to our worst batting performance of the season collapsing to 37 all out. However, the fight that we had shown all season is the fight that was shown by the 11 men who turned up for the occasion. From 4 for 68, we picked up the last 6 wickets for 9 runs dismissing Burwood for 77. An excellent 5 fa from Joe Camarsh and once again well supported by Angus Mackay's 3 wickets and Ben Greaves 2 wickets. We had the game in the balance and all to play for going into the 2<sup>nd</sup> innings wrapping up an eventful Day 1 at 4 for 44 with a lead of 4 runs. We came into Day 2 with a lot of hope and confidence knowing that if we could put up another 70 to 80 runs from our last 6 wickets, we were definitely in the game. However, this was not to be, and we lost 6 cheap wickets for 18 runs leaving Burwood 23 runs to win. We fought hard to the very end taking another 3 scalps with us; however, it wasn't enough, and Burwood were victorious with 7 wickets in hand.

A disappointing end to our finals journey, however I could not be disappointed with the effort and fight shown by our playing group to make it into finals cricket and represent the club with pride. All in all, it was a fantastic season and thoroughly enjoyable as my first as captain of  $2^{nd}$  grade. Everyone who came into the team found a way to contribute to the success of

the season and I'm incredibly proud of what we achieved on the field as well as the culture built off it. I cannot wait to have another crack at it with this young group of lads next season.

There have been 94 recorded instances of bowlers taking seven wickets in an innings. Of these, the best were Lionel Bloomfield (7-7 in 1923-24), Bruce Ames (7-9 in 1953-54) and Dick Pym (7-19 twice in one game in 1965-66) and Ian Fairall (7-27 in 1990-91 & 7-9 in 1994-95).
